

Sage Rose Boarding and Rescue Ranch Rules

- Please No Dogs
- Children are welcome when supervised.
- Anyone riding or participating in horse activities at Sage Rose Boarding and Rescue must sign an Equestrian release. This includes spouses, children, and guests. If they exit the car, must sign release.
- Please cleanup after your horse in all areas including grooming, arena, round pen, and roadways.
- Please be sure to keep gates closed - both arena and pastures.
- Only 1 lesson in arena at one time. Multiple horses allowed in same lesson. Post lessons on board.
- Limit Lunging to moderate speed to protect footing .
- Park in designated areas only (NO CARS OR TRAILERS NEXT TO ARENA OR DRIVING AROUND ARENA BARN.)
- Ride only on designated trails. Avoid riding in open areas. No riding allowed in arena barn aisle.
- Youth riders shall ride with helmets and appropriate boots. Helmets are strongly recommended for adult riders as well.
- Do not turn horses loose in indoor arena.
- Turnout locations and time to be at facility owner's discretion . No turnout on Saturdays to allow maintenance. No blankets on turnout horses.
- Damage to Facility or equipment : Owner and any guests or visitors who accompany an owner onto premises shall be liable for any and all damages to buildings, equipment or premises incurred by owner and owner's horse.
